


 GCSE Results Day 2024: Fakenham Academy doubles number of students with top scores (lynnnews.co.uk) Bertie Ancell, 16, agrees.

Super Saturdays start after October half term.




Half term and Easter holiday "school" intervention

The biggest opportunity is in lessons and homework.


