

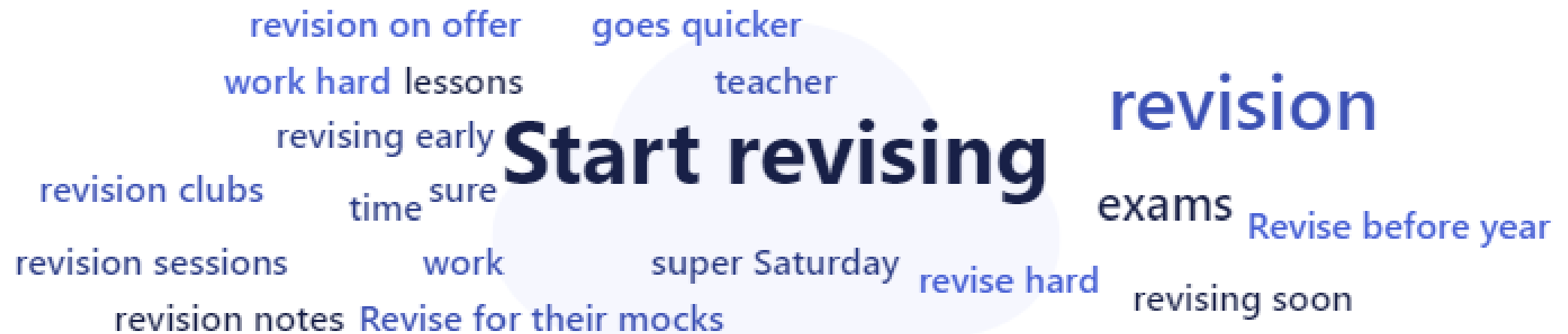

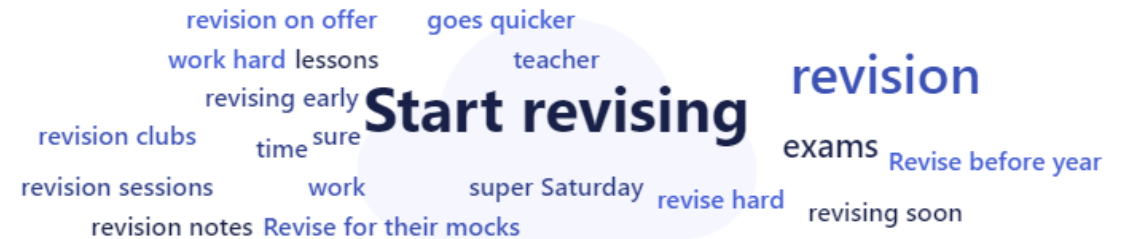

Believe in yourself if you work hard you can do anything just try your best and you can succeeded

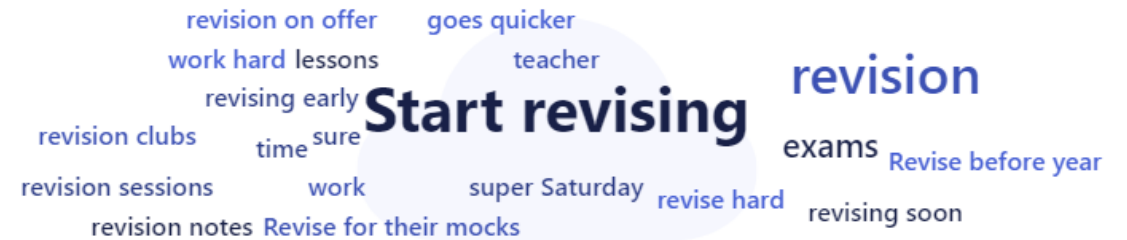

He said he was "really pleased" with his results but wished he had worked harder in year 10.

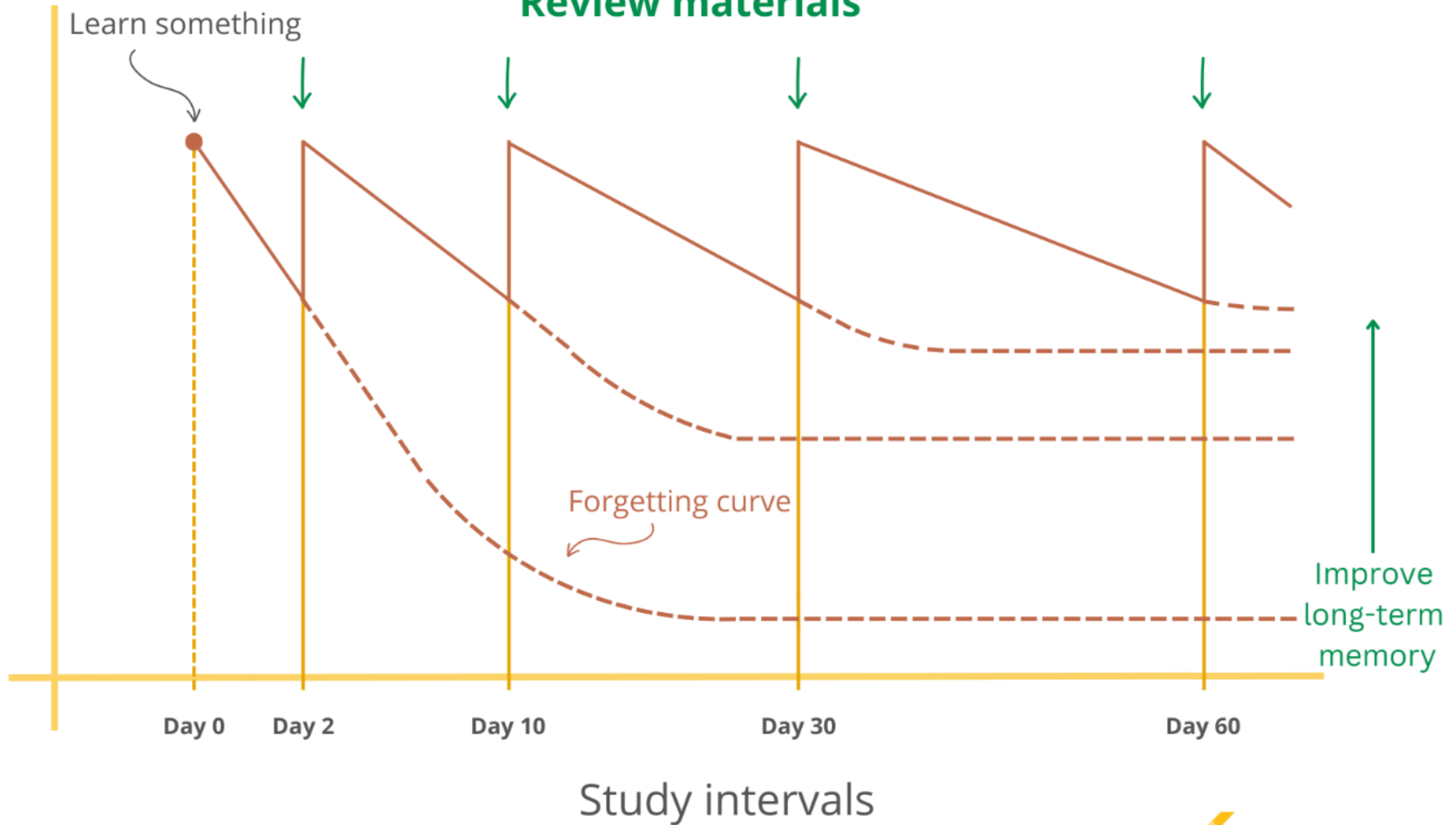

College of West Anglia reported their A*-B rate was 25%.

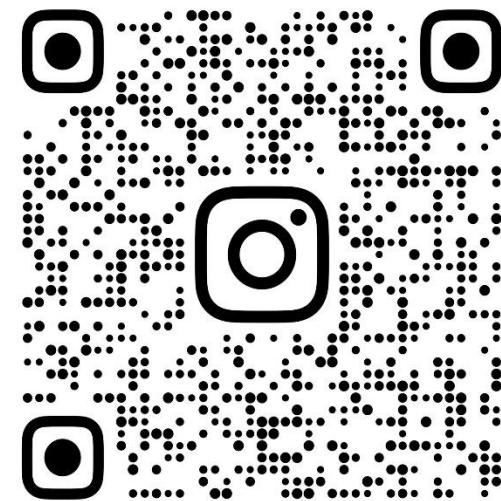
We were a whopping 15% higher.
