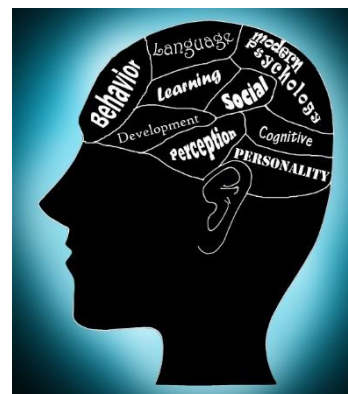
### What will I study?
